## Company Updates

### netociety ltd. — Presented Feb '09

A provider of bespoke social software and collaboration solutions to enterprise clients, is currently in the process of commercialising its product after having successfully completed customer trials with a prototype version of its product which was funded by the Commercialise Fund awarded through Finance South East. It has already started to grow its customer base beyond the trial customers but now seeks equity funding in order to continue with the product development and commercialisation process.

### Statix — Presented Feb '09

A zero emission boiler which uses biomass feedstock and the process absorbs more CO2 than it uses. Since Feb we have identified a market that is in keeping with government guidelines for funding climate change. Funding for developing a process called the Amine process to capture CO2 from power stations. Present work suggests to capture 96% of the CO2 emitted from a power station would cost 8% of the saleable electricity in addition to the cost of running the process. Using Statix boiler to drive the amine process increases the capture efficiency without the loss of marketable power. Additionally, the cost of running the amine process is offset by the revenue from the boiler outputs. The principle of using low emission power supplies to drive the amine process on a high emission facility has been confirmed by a detailed US Dept. of Energy report.

The most significant news is that the UK patent for the process is to be granted on 23/9 and the EU patent is expected in May 2010. Looking for funding and contacts into the energy market for license or sale.

**Mercury Media £150k:** [www.joiningthedocs.tv](http://www.joiningthedocs.tv) an online film rental service a division of MercuryMedia, In 2010 JTD platform will become a multi-platform distributed service, utilising technology for films to be embedded anywhere on the web and earn money. Develop 'Producer Tools' to enable film-makers to upload their own films on their own websites, whilst transacting through the JTD payment portal. 50% funded by the EU and includes Lord Carter (Digital Britain Author). Strategic partners include Telegraph Media Group .

**preonline £95k:** preonline is a new e-learning service for nurses. It allows nurses **to do the courses they need** online anytime anyplace anywhere. By 2014, the projected turnover is £1,090,153 and this is based on 14,400 nurses accessing the service (which is 3% of the UK nurses who have internet access). We already have direct email access to 11,705 nurses and this will be our primary sales route. Looking for an investment of £95k for 20% equity and the exit strategy pays back £700k in 2014.

**LabMinds £150k:** Products to change how experiments are prepared and conducted in Life and Biomedical Science research laboratories worldwide. Lead product EasySolution - part of a complementary three product pipeline - is a machine for automated preparation and mixing of chemical solutions. EasySolution promises to create £billions in savings for universities, research institutes, hospitals, governmental agencies, and corporations while improving the quality and reproducibility of research in the process.

**Diamond Microwave Devices £200k:** Spinning out of Element 6 Technologies to commercialise a high power high frequency diamond transistor for radar and other microwave applications. Funding round shortly to be completed.
